A Message from the Warden

As we move through this year together, there are many things going on at The Church of The Messiah. This is an update including information about some of these happenings.

The Property Committee has been working diligently to identify and prioritize issues and the work to be done to deal with day-to-day issues and

crises. The individual members of the committee are on site frequently. They report to the Vestry regularly so that expenditures are carefully approved and monitored. The members of the committee and the Vestry are anxious to work with others to secure resources to continue to bring all systems on campus up to date and in good working order.

As we move into the next couple of months, the Vestry will be preparing for the Church's annual meeting in May. Part of that preparation is to identify new Vestry members. The Vestry needs the support of congregants to identify potential new Vestry members. If you would like to be considered as a Vestry member, or would like to nominate another congregant for a position on the Vestry, please submit your name or your nominee's name to Barbara Stevenson, Warden (bebstevenson@yahoo.com), Sam Frenkel, Financial Warden (sfrenkel516@gmail.com), Lynn Mangan (lynnmangan3@gmail.com) or Marissa Beaver (beaverm18@gmail.com).

The Vestry will, hopefully, approve the 2024 Church budget at their February meeting. In preparation, the Vestry has with Sam Frenkel's leadership, monitored expenditures, considered alternatives for work to be done, analyzed investment trends, as well as participated in several energetic discussions regarding spending necessities. Part of the process has been to meet with mission leaders to identify goals, request needed monies, prioritize spending and note criteria that will be utilized to evaluate success.

At this point in the Search Process, the Profile Committee is in the final stage of completing its work. The next steps include forwarding the profile to the Vestry and the Diocesan Transition Deacon for approval. Once the approvals are received, the profile will be forwarded to our Search Committee so they can begin their work to identify candidates, with Diocesan support, for our new Rector. The Search Committee will report their progress, as appropriate, through the Spring and beyond, as the process unfolds, to the congregation.

In closing, my heartfelt thanks come to you, our wonderful congregants, for your support of the Vestry, their work for and communication with you, the members of our Property Committee, the Profile Committee and the Search Committee for all they have done and continue to do and the time they devote to the tasks at hand. I extend my thankfulness, and gratitude too, to our dedicated mission groups and their leaders for their selfless work to serve others in the name of our Lord. Thank you and bless you, everyone, for contributing all that you do to our caring Messiah Church Family.

Creative Angels

As I've talked with some of you about recipe choices, you've made me aware that vegetarian recipes are favorites! I have made this Vegetable Stir Fry as both a side dish, as well as, a main course offering. It's a refreshing change.

Vegetable Stir Fry

- 1 large carrot, sliced
- 2 cups medium broccoli florets
- 8 oz can baby corn spears, drained
- 8 oz mushrooms, sliced or quartered
- 1 whole pepper, seeded and sliced
- 2 Tablespoons cooking oil
- 2 Tablespoons unsalted butter
- 2 teaspoons ginger, ground

Stir Fry Sauce

1/4 cup chicken broth

1/2 cup teaspoon cornstarch

- 3 Tablespoons low sodium soy sauce
- 2 Tablespoons honey
- 1/4 teaspoon hot sauce, optional

In a large non-stick or wok, over medium heat, heat the oil. Add vegetables and stir fry about 3 minutes or until vegetables are crisp tender. Add the butter, ginger and cook until fragrant. In a small bowl, combine all the ingredients sor the stir fry sauce. Pour the sauce over the vegetables and stir. Turn heat down to medium low and cook three to four minutes, until sauce thickens and vegetables are desired tenderness.


